Parents will be required to sign their child in at the start of the day and out at the end of the day.

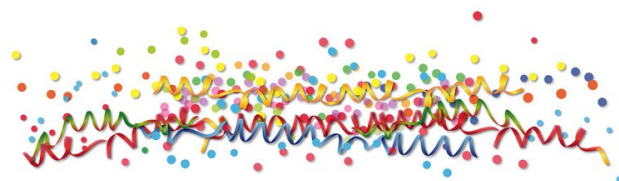
