Principal's Message

Aboriginal Education

This term at Goulburn Public School an Aboriginal Education program has been developed and implemented across K-6 classes. The students have an opportunity to learn about Aboriginal culture, histories and experiences. Our K-2 students have been exploring Aboriginal understanding of the world, it's creation, and its great stories through Aboriginal Dreamtime. The Aboriginal people believe that the earth and everything in it was made by their ancestral spirits. This is called the Dreamtime or the Dreaming. It was a time when the rivers, mountains, rocks, deserts and plants were made. The Dreamtime stories are an important part of the Aboriginal culture. Our Stage 2 students are developing an understanding of

'Acknowledgement to Country' so that they can show awareness of and respect for the original

Indigenous custodians of the land on which events are held. Stage 3 have been exploring the Aboriginal traditions of using the land as a sustainable resource for survival. Students are enjoying these lessons!



Please look through the lost property and find any of your missing items. At the end of this term any items remaining without names will be donated to our school clothing pool.




