

I'm in the bathroom too



Down came the rain and washed poor Wincy out




BEETLE IN THE GARDEN


You will need:

- Green paper (for the grass)
- Square piece of cardboard (any colour for the background)
 - Pencils, textas or crayons
 - * Piece of paper
 - Scissors
 - Glue




- 1) On your piece of paper draw a beetle starting with it's eyes, add head, nose and mouth, draw a body and legs, add spots and antennas, now colour it any bright colours you like.
- 2) Cut around your beetle.
- 3) Cut you green paper into grassy looking strips.
- 4) Glue your grass on to your square piece of cardboard.





* If you have enough space, you could add more beetles or ants or a butterfly *


