You will need :

A paper plate Paper Textas or crayons or pencils Patty Cases Scissors Glue

How to make your paper plate clown

- Cut out a triangle for the hat and decorate, glue to the top of the paper plate
- Draw a mouth on a piece of paper and cut around it, glue on to your paper plate or draw on the paper plate
- Draw eyes or glue on patty cases for eyes
- Draw a nose (clowns often have round red nose)
- Trace around your hands and cut out. Glue either side of the paper plate to be the clowns hair.
