

And then there were 3


3 green grasshoppers










What's in the Grass?

- 3) Color the blades of grass green.







Let's make Garbage Truck

You will need:
Empty cereal box
4 Yogurt pouch lids
Scissors
A straw





Glue



- Open out your cereal box and draw your garbage truck or use the template on the next page
- Colour your truck then cut out (you might need a little help with this)
 - Cut the straw in half, make 4 holes for the straw on the garbage truck
- Push the straw through the holes, glue a lid to each end of the straw. You will need a lot of glue.
- Sticky tape the top of the garbage truck together. It doesn't matter if each side a different size, mine is.
- Once your wheels have dried, take your garbage truck for a drive and see what garbage you can collect.




